Białystok, 15-16.04.2024

The conference is a continuation of the International Scientific and Didactic Seminar “Philological Education - Research Trends and Didactic Applications,” which took place in Białystok in 2021.

The aim of the conference is to exchange experiences on broadly understood higher education, both in the context of didactics of individual subjects and research in the field of disciplines dominant in philological education, i.e. linguistics and literary studies. We propose the following areas of reflection:

- Linguistic and literary areas of research of master's students, doctoral students, and academics
- Linguistics and literary education - trends in teaching in philological fields
- Effective, modern teaching methods and teaching aids (including IT) in philological education
- Specialties, syllabi, plans, educational programs - their types, functionality, and applications
- Remote, face-to-face, hybrid teaching
- Internationalization of the education process
- Education of doctoral students at the doctoral school – strengths and weaknesses
- ChatGPT – opportunity or threat?
- Student and faculty motivation
- Monitoring student achievements
- Evaluation of the potential and effectiveness of university employees in the field of teaching
- Support system for academic teachers in their teaching work
- University education and the needs of the labor market, profile, and professional fate of graduates

We are also open to your proposals that will fit into the area of research on philological education.

The conference will be in a hybrid form.

- **Sending topics with a summary** (150-250 words): by **January 15, 2024**. Please send the submission form by e-mail to ksztalceniefilologiczne@uwb.edu.pl. In the event of many applications, the organizers reserve the right to select papers.
- **Notification of acceptance:** by January 30, 2024.
- **Conference fee:** PLN 450 (€100) for those participating in the in-person mode or PLN 350 (€80) for those participating remotely, and it includes printing articles in a multi-author monograph in a publishing house listed by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education. The in-person conference fee also covers a gala dinner, refreshments during breaks in the session, and conference materials. The fee does not include travel and accommodation costs.
